I am a homeowner on Lurs Ct, I am against this project that has become a transitional home for people who have mental illness and will be eventually moving out to live on their own. While I believe everyone needs a place to live, I personally do not want a business right next door. I do not have a solution, but am requesting that this permit of expanding this house to accommodate 12 beds be denied. I believe I have the right to raise my children in a <u>safe neighborhood</u> and not next to a business that brings more congestion to my street as well as potential saftey concerns. I am concerned because I have already witnessed incidents that allow me to believe that more beds will equal more potential problems.

Incidents that have occurred already:

#1 On October 21st – As I was driving home, I saw a worker having to talk down a man that had left the home and walked out of the neighborhood. As my family and I left to go to dinner 2 workers were walking/"escorting" the man back to the home.

#2 On October 22nd – As I was driving home, on the corner of my street (Lurs) were multiple workers talking down a girl and about an hour later when I left to go to an appointment – 2-3 cops were on the scene with the workers and the girl.

We have several homes on this street that have young children that like to play outside and up and down the street. Now, <u>this is a safety issue for our children</u> as well as adding more cars and traffic to a street that is already congested.

I ask that you protect the residents of this street and neighborhood – let us live in peace and safety. Our homes should be a place of rest, safety, and a sanctuary for our children. I did not buy a home to live next to a business, I bought a home to live in a neighborhood.
