I strongly oppose CUP#1246 for the following reasons:

Houses in this subdivision are big with four to six bedrooms. They are occupied by large families with many cars parking on the streets. More so during the corona virus pandemic. These adult care facilities come with employees, visitors, sheriff's deputies, coroner's officers, fire trucks, ambulance, and delivery trucks at all hours taking up street parking spaces and blocking neighborhood traffic.

In addition, noises generated by service vehicles will disturb the peace and quiet of our neighborhood. This type of facility will generate a lot of garbage. If more refuse bins are added, they will take up more parking spaces and block adjacent driveways. We have roll curbs in our subdivision and many houses have two plus one car garage. There are limited spaces between houses for refuse, green and recycle bins on collection days.

Finally, this type of facility are lowering property values in the neighborhood.
