DESCRIPTION

The Recycling Division is responsible for collection of all recyclable material within City limits. At this time, this includes scheduled and unscheduled service for residential customers.

MISSION

To provide the citizens of Merced excellent recycling services, which help meet State mandates, preserve quality of life, and enhance the City's general appearance.

GOALS

 Provide regular collection of residential, co-mingled, single stream recyclables in the most efficient and cost-effective manner.

OBJECTIVES

 Continue to monitor and adjust right sizing of recycling service routes to accommodate growth, as well as improve productivity. All routes will be continually audited during fiscal year, and adjustments implemented as necessary.

PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENTS/INDICATORS

2. Track diversion of material from the landfill, as mandated by the State of California. Track tonnage of recyclables collected and compare to original estimates of diversion.

2004-2005 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

A Residential Recycling Program began operations in FY 2003. The recycling rate approval included the ability to automatically adjust rates, based on CPI factors each January 1, beginning in 2004, and concluding in 2006. As a result of increases in the CPI an adjustment to the recycling rate was made in January 2004.
