Am I eligible for the program?

Active employees, early retirees, COBRA participants and their dependents on PRISM Health Anthem, Blue Shield, or Delta Health Systems PPO or EPO plans are eligible. Medicare primary and HMO plans are not eligible at this time.

Which procedures are covered?

Eligible procedures include:

A. *Bariatrics* (gastric sleeve / bypass): must be available through your employer's health plan.

- B. Coronary Bypass Surgery
- **C.** Other outpatient musculoskeletal procedures:
 - a. Shoulder
 - b. Elbow
 - c. Wrist/Hand
 - d. Hip and Knee non-replacement
 - e. Ankle/Foot (e.g., Achilles tendon repair)
- C. Spinal Procedures
- D. Total hip and total knee replacement

How do I qualify for these services?

The following criteria must be met to qualify for the Carrum Health program:

- A. You have primary medical coverage through an eligible PRISM Health plan.
- B. You meet the medical requirements for your procedure. Contact us to learn more!
- C. Your local physician agrees to assume post-operative care for you.
- D. You have an adult caregiver (21+) able to assist you during your care and travel.

How do I get started?

After registration you will be asked to provide more detailed information about your condition and your treating doctors. Your Patient Care Specialist will gather and transfer your medical records to your chosen hospital.

Which services and expenses are covered?

Coverage includes the following:

A. All medical expenses associated with your surgical procedure at your chosen facility. This includes a consultation appointment, medical equipment (e.g. walker), and prescriptions upon discharge.

B. Travel expenses for you and one adult companion. This includes transportation, lodging, parking, baggage, and a daily stipend for meals. Your Patient Care Specialist will arrange all travel for you and your companion.

What about recovery care post-discharge?

Your Patient Care Specialist will ensure you smoothly transition back to local care. Post-op care will be billed to your PRISM Health plan, including physical therapy and follow-up appointments with your local specialist.
