

#### 2023/2024 Strategic Planning Session

Last Saturday, City Council and Staff met for the annual strategic planning meeting to discuss the 2023/24 Council Goals & Priorities. City Council annually reviews and updates these goals and priorities to guide budget development and establish consensus on policies and projects impacting city residents, businesses, and the community.

Priorities include Downtown & Economic Development, Housing and the Unhoused, Merced Unity Project, Natural Disaster/Flood Response, Parks & Recreation, Public Safety, Public Works & City Beautification, South Merced Study, and Quality of Life.

Council is scheduled to adopt the fiscal 2023/24 Goals and Priorities at the upcoming February 21st City Council Meeting.





#### **OES Type 3 Engine Delivered to Merced City Fire**

Recently, Merced City Fire took delivery of a 2007 OES Type 3 Engine.

The Type 3 Office of Emergency Service (OES) Engine is designed for woodland firefighting. OES is part of the statewide master mutual aid system. Merced City Fire has been part of this system for many years. This Engine will allow the department to offer support in ways that have not been possible. In addition, the Type 3 designation allows for off-road operations in areas larger Engines (Type 1 or 2) cannot access.

A Type 3 Engine is often four-wheel drive and has better clearance than its larger counterparts. Type 1 and 2 Engines often perform structure protection on wildland fires. The department's prior OES Engine was a Type 1.

Type 3 Engines are essential to access difficult terrain. These assignments are more difficult due to terrain and access. In addition, this Type 3 will allow crews to gain the skills necessary to provide service to the outlying areas of Merced that a Type 1 Engine cannot access.



### Traffic Lights at 16<sup>th</sup> & G Street are Repaired

Recently, the driver of a semi-truck incorrectly estimated the truck's turning radius and took out a utility pole at  $16^{\text{th}}$  & G, causing damage to the traffic light system. Public Works crews replaced the system, which is now fully operational.



#### Have you Herd?

The goats are back at the City of Merced Wastewater Treatment Plant. A herd of 938 goats will graze for the next few weeks and will cover approximately 700 acres near the plant where the city farms winter wheat, alfalfa, and corn to support a sustainable operations program.

The practice of using goats and sheep for weed and vegetation control has been around for centuries. This prescribed or targeted grazing will manage weeds, stubble, and unwanted vegetation. It's an eco-friendly way to keep the weeds at bay.

• There were 0 MFD permits issued during this period. (no change since last report)

Commercial & Industrial permits issued:

- There were 0 new construction commercial permits issued during this period.
- There were 2 new tenant improvement permits issued during this period; one for a 2,249 SF McDonald's located at 1821 Motel Dr., and one for a 2,500 SF Sephora in Kohl's located at 851 W. Olive Ave. #400.

Commercial & Industrial permits submitted:

- There were 0 new construction commercial permits submitted during this period.
- There were 3 new tenant improvement permits submitted during this period; one for a 1,800 SF Rally's located at 3105 N Hwy 59, one for a 896 SF convenience store located at 900 Loughborough Dr Ste D, and one for a 30,000 SF Walmart remodel to include racking located at 3055 Loughborough Dr.

Commercial & Industrial Certificates of Occupancy (CofOs)

• There were 3 commercial and industrial CofOs issued for this period; one for a 3,858 SF Quest Diagnostics located at 3377 G St Ste A, one for a 4,788 SF remodel at 1343 W Main St., and one for a truss repair and door & wall addition at 933 W 15<sup>th</sup> St.
