- Question 1 On a very hot day, can pours began at 7:00 AM? Answer – Yes
- Question 2 Is the City providing a staging area? Answer – Contractor is responsible for their own staging.
- Question 3 –Will work be allowed on the weekend? Answer – No
- Question 4 –Is compaction testing required at each site? Answer – Testing must be performed for each location.
- Question 5 –How will construction water be obtained? <u>Answer</u> – Fire hydrate water meter can be pick up at Public Work. There is a \$4000.00 deposit and a \$50.00 fee.
- Question 6– Is SWPPP required since the project is less than 1 acre?Answer– Water pollution control best management practices should be used on this project to<br/>protect the storm system. A SWPPP is not needed if soil disturbance including stockpiles and staging<br/>area will be less than 1 acre.
