Merced PD's Detective Sannadan Secures Bronze at US Police & Fire Championships Biathlon

Merced PD Detective Sannadan earned third place at the US Police & Fire Championships (USPFC) Biathlon Competition and received a bronze medal. The USPFC Biathlon Competition consists of two components: Pistol shooting and Cross-Country running with a total of 3 miles and 24 rounds from the 24-yard range.

The USPFC is an Olympic-style competition that began in San Diego 57 years ago with athletes representing law enforcement, firefighters, and officers from corrections, probation, border protection, immigration, and customs from across the country. The idea was to promote fitness and create camaraderie among the different law enforcement groups.

Detective Sannadan has dedicated 18 years to law enforcement, serving in various capacities. He started in patrol and quickly advanced to the Disruptive Area Response Team (DART). Later, he became a detective specializing in elder abuse as a liaison. Committed to training, he has served as a Defensive Tactics Instructor, a Taser Instructor, and a Pre-Academy Physical Training Instructor. Detective Sannadan is currently a firearms instructor, bringing his extensive experience and expertise to this critical role.
