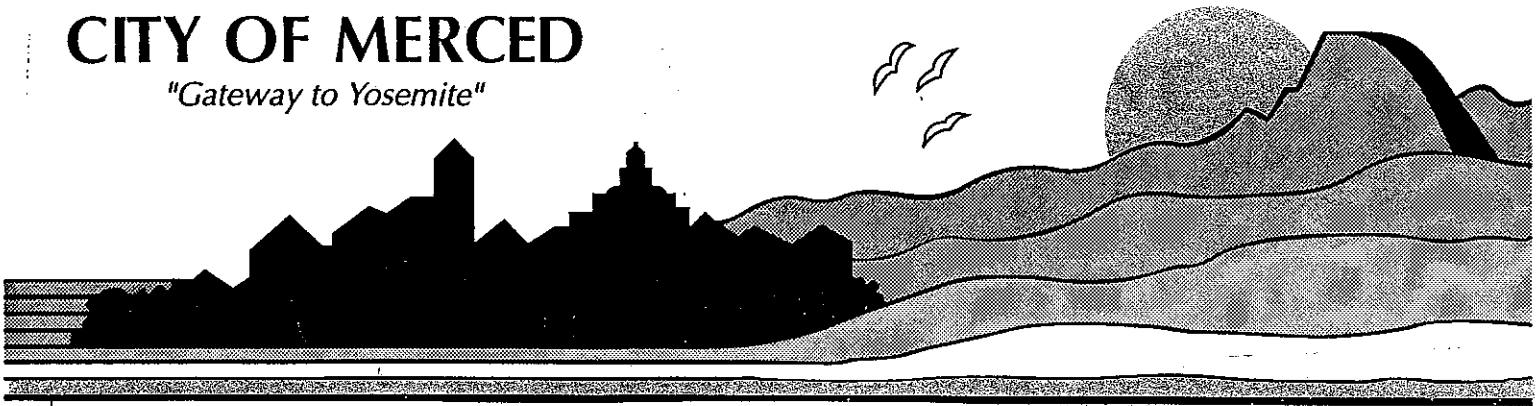

INTRODUCTION

This information is presented to make home owners aware of the requirements for abandoning a conventional in-ground pool or spa. This work required a Building Permit. If the existing pool location is to be built over, a separate soils compaction report is required.

POOL DEMOLITION REQUIREMENTS

The bottom needs to be removed for drainage. i.e. several holes punched through the bottom.

The pool coping and the top 18" of the pool wall shall be removed.

Removal of any above ground pool plumbing including pumps and heaters.

Removal of the electrical sub-panel and the electrical sub-feed back to the electric service supply location. Conversion of the existing pool electrical system to any other use will require a separate permit and approval.

Inspection is required before the pool / spa is filled in.

The pool / spa must be filled in with sand (type SE25), dirt (compacted to 90%) or gravel.

If the site will be built on, a certified compaction report from a recognized lab is necessary.
