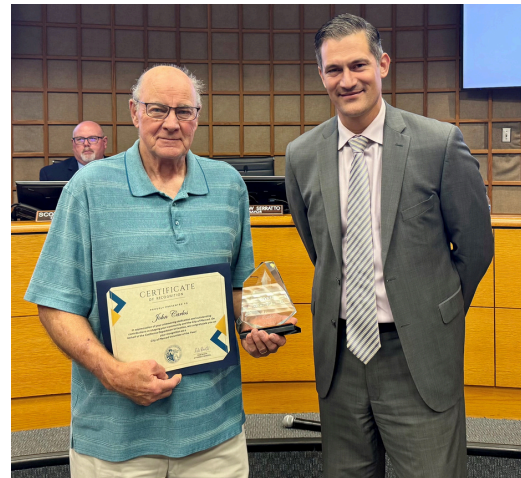
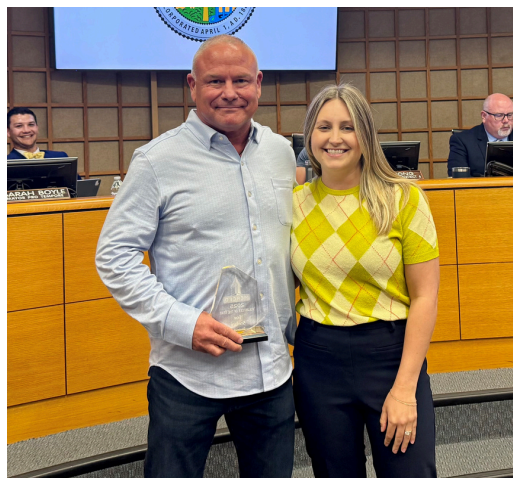
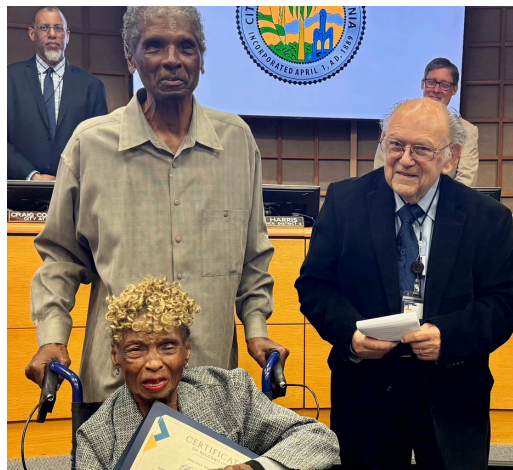

Progress continues on the Merced Yosemite Regional Airport Terminal Project.

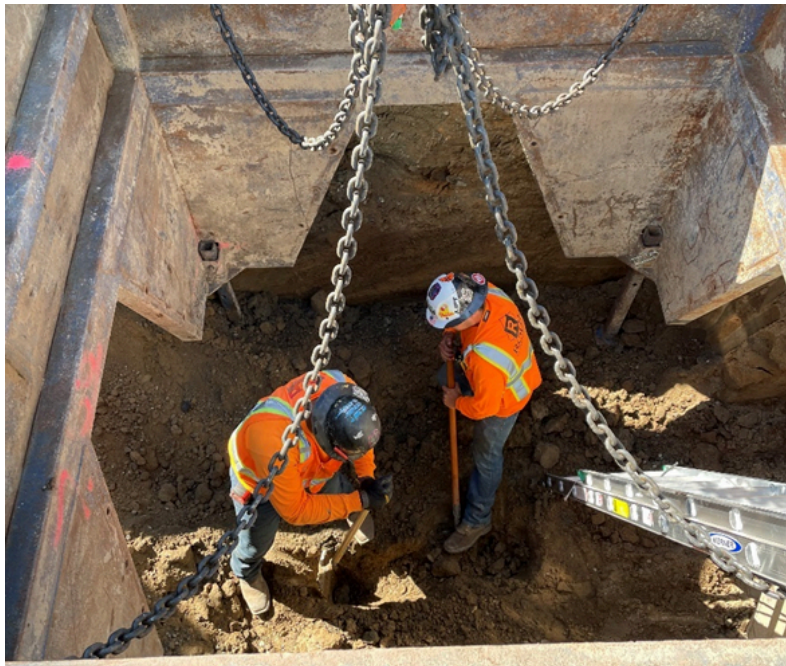
