NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Engineer has caused to be prepared and filed with the City Clerk, revised reports, in writing, which provide the basis for the levy of benefit assessments for the costs of maintenance and operation on all lots or parcels of property within said maintenance districts. Said reports set forth the amounts to be provided in the budget for maintenance and operation, a description of each lot or parcel of property in the maintenance district, by assessor's parcel number, and the amount of assessment to be levied for the fiscal year 2026/2027 against each lot or parcel of property. Said reports are open to public inspection.

Said reports will be heard by the City Council at its Public Meeting to be held on Monday, June 1, 2026, and its Public Hearing to be held on Monday, June 15, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 678 W. 18th Street, Merced, California, at which times said Council will examine said reports and hear all persons interested therein.

Any interested owners, objecting to the amount of the assessment on any lot or parcel of property owned by him, may file with the City Clerk at or before the hour fixed for hearing protests, in writing, signed by him, describing the lot or parcel of property so that it may be identified, and stating the grounds of his protest, and may appear at said hearing and be heard in regard thereto.
