NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the City Council of the City of Merced will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 18, 2026, at or about the hour of 6:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, 678 West 18th Street, Merced, California to consider the following:

“AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, EXTENDING FOR
A PERIOD OF TEN MONTHS AND FIFTEEN DAYS, IN
ACCORDANCE WITH MERCED CITY CHARTER AND
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65858, A TEMPORARY
MORATORIUM ON STREET CLOSURES WITHIN THE
CITY OF MERCED”

Pursuant to Merced City Charter and Government Code §65858, this Ordinance extends the temporary moratorium on street closures within the City of Merced under Ordinance No. 2590, for a period of ten (10) months and fifteen (15) days. If adopted, this Ordinance would be effective until April 2, 2027.

All persons are invited to be present at the public hearing. Written and oral testimony is invited. Notice is hereby further given that if you challenge the above referenced Ordinance in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing.
