

FACILITIES CONDITION INDEX





FCI REPRESENTS PROJECTED REPAIR COSTS AS A PERCENT OF REPLACEMENT COST










FMP SPACE PROGRAM (2028)







- Enhance community partnerships











PEDESTRIAN CIRCULATION

Pedestrian Path






