Permission to use water from the City's water system is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. Hydrant shall only be operated with an approved hydrant wrench, approved reduced pressure principle back flow prevention device assembly and water meter (in accordance with W-35 and W-36).
2. Fittings shall be examined and approved by the Fire Department prior to connection to the hydrant.
3. The charge indicated below shall be paid prior to the use of any water.
4. When the hydrant is not in actual use, the hydrant shall be turned off, the hose removed, and the nozzle cap replaced.
5. This permit (or a photocopy) shall be on the job site at all times the hydrant is in use.
6. This permit is valid only for Hydrant No. _____ from _____ through _____
7. Applicant shall be responsible for all cost incurred if the hydrant is damaged, including repair of the hydrant and any property damage that can be attributed to the hydrant damage.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THESE CONDITIONS SHALL CONSTITUTE GROUND FOR CANCELLATION OF THIS PERMIT.
