FIRE DEPARTMENT ANNUAL AUTO EXTRICATION TRAINING

The Fire Department conducted their annual auto extrication training this week utilizing four donated vehicles from Tesla. Firefighters were able to familiarize themselves with the shutdown procedures associated with the electric vehicles and enhanced extrication techniques. Members also took the opportunity to practice lifting heavy objects with new equipment carried on the department's aerial apparatus.





HANDS-ONLY CPR SAVE MAN'S LIFE

On March 17, 2018, early notification and immediate hands-only CPR, assisted in saving the life of a 71-year old male, Gary Eno, who was playing tennis at Merced College. After collapsing on the tennis court, two separate tennis players at the college, Judge Quall and Marty Sullivan, performed hands-only CPR on Mr. Eno until first responders (Fire Department and Riggs Ambulance) arrived to successfully continue lifesaving interventions. Subsequently, Mr. Eno was flown out to Stanford Hospital for further treatment.

Mr. Eno met with his lifesaving team on Monday to personally thank them and let the first responders know that his tennis game is better than ever thanks to everyone's intervention.

This incident reinforces the importance of hands-only CPR. Hands-only CPR maintains critical circulation of the heart and brain and keeps the patient viable, thereby allowing our first responder's interventions to work.

Together, the Fire Department and Riggs Ambulance will continue their partnership to promote and educate the public on hands-only CPR.
